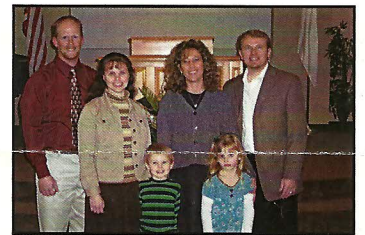


Dear Friends,

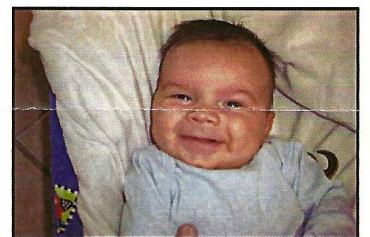

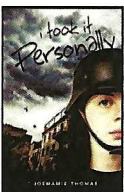
