Jeff has two new students; Allen is 17, and Bernave is 35 and a teacher here in town and in the community of Cushámen. We see

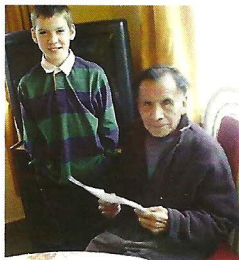


God opening many doors into the Cushámen community.
