Greetings from Romania,

As you can see from the picture taken from our church van route, we have already begun to get snow here in Eastern Europe. The temperatures vary from week to week, and we are blessed and content with whatever the Lord sends. Life changes like the weather. Praise the Lord that our God never changes. He is the same holy, loving, powerful, wise God from the beginning to the end. You can trust a God like that!

This month we have seen many passages about thankfulness in our verse by verse preaching of the Bible. Therefore, we had a Thanksgiving Sunday in our church in Brasov (picture below) in obedience to the Scriptures. Romania, as the rest of Europe, does not recognize Thanksgiving in any month. The holiday is not the only thing that goes unobserved. Most people live unthankful lives. This is sadly true even for the ones who are forced into the traditional observance of the holiday by society. Nevertheless, we decided to have a full Sunday of giving thanks to our great Saviour without one complaint from sunrise to sunset. We endeavoured not to ask our God for blessings but instead just thank Him for what He has already done and provided for us. The service was most blessed. We had preaching, singing, testimonies, and a meal provided for all the 43 people who came. What a joy and sense of peace rested on us!

God has continued His grace upon us as we minister in the city center each week. The preaching and tract distribution continues without a problem. This past week we had four Romanian men preaching the gospel of Jesus Christ with the American throwing his two cents in as well. We will not fail to obey the command to sow the seed of the word of God. Our obedience and motives do not rest in how the multitude responds but in the command of the One who died for us.

Continue to pray for the rich man, Codreanu, who God is using to give us our building and grounds. The man still needs to understand true salvation through Jesus Christ alone. He recently offered another building for our use which we plan on remodeling to help faithful Christian families that need housing in this difficult financial environment. Believing in our work, the man also is incredibly trying to pay his employees to come to church. Recently, we had 10 unsaved Orthodox men come on a Wednesday night. They got the gospel gun-barrel straight and literature to take home and read. Though none received Christ, we were able to have good conversations after the preaching. Pray for fruit from the seed sown.
