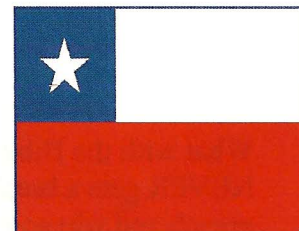

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

While winter has continued to chill and drench southern Chile (with a few relieving clear days scattered throughout the month), and as the nation as a whole has passed on from being rocked by earthquakes to being rocked by violent student protests ("higher education" yielding its expected fruits), your little squadron of soul-winning fellowsoldiers here has continued to **"war a good warfare"** and achieve the objective of the Church's mission in **"the ministry of reconciliation,"** in spite of the overwhelming Laodicean spiritual winter blasting us from all sides (facilitated by the Church's lukewarmness as the love of many "waxes cold"). And while nowhere near as great a blessing as the souls who have responded to **"the word of reconciliation"** presented faithfully by this little band of **"ambassadors for Christ"** (beseeching both **"publicly, and from house to house,"** and even in taxicabs - which I am sure Paul would have mentioned had there been such a facility in his day!), it's hard to describe the personal joy it was to accompany the group to labour in the fields on an especially miserable afternoon (driving freezing rain, gusting wind, etc.) recently. Although the climatic conditions were awful, and in spite of the fact that almost nobody was out and about, the brethren assembled at the appointed hour, and were *joyfully desirous* to go to the work and deal with the few people that passed by as the men preached; they would have been genuinely disappointed if I had called it off (although our "policy" is to always go out and evangelize before each service time, regardless of weather or any other factor). Not the kind of thing one sees too much anymore in "Laodicea," and we thank God for what He hath wrought in these believers here, and for working through all of you to allow us to be here as labourers together with Him, in His husbandry, in His building. Here are the names of the souls resultant of this month's "public harvesting," for which we ask you to thank Him, and pray for their spiritual growth: *Juan, Diego, Cristian, Evelyn, Manuel, Mauricio,* (another) *Juan, Alfredo, Silvana,* (another) *Diego, Samuel, Jaime, Pablo, Tamara, Elmo, Jose, Brian, and Miguel.* Those last 2 are boys of 10 and 11 years of age, respectively, led to Christ by Luis of the Paillaco church when they approached him to ask about our preaching and Scripture signs; they explained to him that the Catholic priest in Paillaco is instructing his "parishioners" regarding us, especially as concerns our preaching against religious idols ("saints," "the Virgin," etc.). It is always good to receive testimony from inside the Enemy's camp of the danger of the "heresies" propagated by our "sect," but infinitely better to know that Jesus Christ saved 2 more from the eternal fire to which that camp leads. Our "cult" also preached the "lies" found in 1 Corinthians 15:1-4 and Romans 10:9-13 to the following souls, but they went away without acting in faith on what the Holy Spirit showed them there, so pray that they might have another chance to be saved: *Edelberto, Segundo, Miriam, Erna, Hector, Hernan and Luis.*

In individual labours, Regulo was able to lead his aunt *Magaly* to the Lord Jesus this month, as well as an insurance salesman named *Jose Luis* (who Regulo "sold" on *eternal* life insurance). Luis led *Yeni* to salvation in Christ at his home, and I led *Alvaro*, a taxi driver, to the same, showing him verses from the Spanish Soul Winner's New Testament (provided by the Valera Bible Society printing ministry of our home church) as he drove me through traffic to my destination (I hope that doesn't violate the **"lawfully"** of 2 Timothy 2:5). Please pray for a coworker of Regulo's wife Roxanna, named *Ana*, whom they are trying to lead to the LORD, and the same for a coworker of Luis, named *Juan*.
