Simple definitions:

Pentecost: (vs. 1) means 50 and represents a feast occurring 50 days after Passover. One of 7 feasts celebrated by the Jews. Outlined in Lev. 23:15-21

Cloven: (vs. 3) cleave, cut in half. Kind of like a snakes tongue.

Intro chap. 2: More people get messed up in this single chapter than any other, and that is why it is so important to have a handle on this chapter. There are three misguided ideas about this chapter. They are as following:

1. Vs. 1-11 have some people teaching that Pentecost is an experience that Church Age Christians are to seek.
2. Vs. 16-21 some have misapplied Joel 2 in such a way that many seek an unscriptural experience that they believe is part of the latter rain.
3. Vs. 38 has led many to hell as they have put their faith in their baptism to save them. This is called baptismal regeneration.

In this lesson we are going to look primarily at Pentecost.
